Android Mobile Devices

ICANotes is compatible with almost every Android mobile device. Please follow these instructions to connect to ICANotes through your mobile device.

1). Go to your devices' App Store (Google Play Store), search for "Microsoft Remote Desktop." The app should look similar to this:



Install the application.

2). Once downloaded, open the app and tap the plus sign in the upper right-hand corner to add a new remote desktop connection (ICANotes).



3). Choose Desktop.



4). You'll see a screen like this:



5). Select PC name and enter "internet.icanotes.com" into this field, without quotation marks.

6). For security, be sure to click Enter every time under Username.

4). Once it has been downloaded, tap the button to open the application.



5). Once the application is opened, tap the plus sign 🕂 in the upper right-hand corner



6). When the Add New window pops up, click the > symbol in the Desktop row (as shown below in the green box).
